

HOW TO ACCESS THE ERIC BERNE ARCHIVE


Step 1: Go to http://ericbernearchives.org and click on the blue "Click here to visit the Eric L. Berne Archive" button under the photographs:




Step 2: You will now be on the Archives and Special Collections website of the University of California:
